With the changes resulting from the approved State proposals Nov. 2018 you can now:

Register to vote up to and even on Election Day

Reinstates straight-party voting

No reason absentee voting-you still have to complete an application for each election

Automatic voter registration at Sec. of State offices-when obtaining or renewing driver's license or State ID card if you are a U.S. citizen and 18 or older.

TREASURER:This newsletter will arrive with your summer tax bills that are **due by Monday**, **September 14**, ²⁰²⁰. We send tax bills to everyone even if you have them paid by your mortgage company. Look on the upper left corner of the tax stub at the bottom third of the tax bill where it says "Mortgage Co." if there is a company printed there they are asking for the tax bill to process payment. We send the tax bill to you so you know how much your taxes are that the mortgage company is paying.

Payments received after September 14., 2020 will have a 1% interest added each and every month thereafter. Mail payments to:
